Great Adventures Program for Preschoolers

Children ages 3-5 will enjoy this program designed to meet their emotional, social, creative and physical needs. Based on the premise that children learn through play, participants will have numerous opportunities to explore, create, discover, problem solve, and communicate to encourage appropriate skills and development.

Caring, nurturing experienced staff members implement a progressive program using themes to introduce and expose students to colors, shapes, numbers, and letters through a friendly, fun atmosphere. A balance of whole group and small group activities encourage academic and listening skills along with social interaction. Each classroom consists of two instructors and approximately 18 students.

All children must be completely toilet trained to participate. Children must be 3-years-old by September 1, 2010 to be enrolled in the 3-year-old program and children must be 4-years-old by September 1, 2010 to be enrolled in the 4-year-old program. Children who turn 5 years old by December 15, 2010 may enroll in our Finally Five Sections. LA
