Continue your day after lunch in the heart of Chicago's loop at the First United Methodist Church - Chicago Temple. Tour the ground floor sanctuary and then make your pilgrimage 400 feet above the streets of Chicago (two elevators and a set of stairs) to admire the charming Chapel in the Sky, reputed to be the highest place of worship above ground in the world.
