Great Adventures Program for Preschoolers

Children ages 3-5 will enjoy this program designed to meet their emotional, social, creative and physical needs. Based on the premise that children learn through play, participants will have numerous opportunities to explore, create, discover, problem solve, and communicate to encourage appropriate skills and development.

Caring, nurturing experienced staff members implement a progressive program using themes to introduce and expose students to colors, shapes, numbers, and letters through a friendly, fun atmosphere. A balance of whole group and small group activities encourage academic and listening skills along with social interaction. Each classroom consists of two instructors and approximately 18 students.

All children must be completely toilet trained to participate. Children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2010 to be enrolled in the 3-year-old program and children must be 4 years old by September 1, 2010 to be enrolled in the 4-year-old program. Online registration is not accepted for this program. To reserve your placement in the lottery, your application must be accompanied by a \$75 non-refundable registration fee (see schedule below). If you have recently moved or have never registered for a Plainfield Park District program, please bring proof of residency (a tax or utility bill). Check or credit card (Visa/Mastercard/Discover) payments are accepted. A copy of the child's immunization records and birth certificate will be due at a later date.

On Friday, March 26, 2010, the lottery registration will occur. All submitted applications will be drawn and placed into classes accordingly. Once classes are filled, names will continue to be drawn and placed in order on a waiting list. Confirmations will be mailed within one week of the lottery.
