### Inclusion

JBSRA provides inclusion services for individuals who wish to participate in general recreation programs. An individual with a disability can have a beneficial and rewarding experience by participating with their peers without a disability. JBSRA can provide support to an inclusive experience by training staff, adapting activities, working with behavioral modifications and providing support staff.

Each individual needs to be aware of a few simple guidelines prior to an inclusive experience. When registering, make sure to indicate on the registration form that you need accommodations. Be aware of and able to follow the rules of conduct for the program, with or without accommodations. Be willing to participate in the scheduled activities. JBSRA works cooperatively with you and the Park District to provide reasonable accommodations.

### Special Olympics Illinois Medical Applications

JBSRA competes in Illinois Area 7 events and competitions. Persons eligible for Special Olympics are eight years or older and have been identified by an agency or professional as having mental retardation or a cognitive delay as determined by standardized measure, or have significant learning or vocational problems due to cognitive delay that require, or have required, specially designed instruction. To participate in a program that competes in Special Olympics, a current medical application must be on file with the state office before program registration. ### SUMMER DAY CAMP

JBSRA will be offering three camps this year - early childhood, children's camp and teen camp - for two 4-week sessions. At each camp site, campers are assigned to small groups based on age and ability. The goal of camp is to help each camper improve motor skills and physical fitness; encourage campers to interact with peers; retain skills through activities to increase attention span, fine motor, self expression and language skills; and provide daily experiences that help each child feel successful and good about themselves.

**Camp Sessions:** Camp will run Monday-Thursday, June 7-July 1 and July 5-29 (dates subject to change based on number of snow days used by SD 202).

**Camp Sites:** All camps will take place at Lincoln Elementary School, 14740 Meadow Lane in Plainfield.

**Camp Staff:** Each camp site has a director, assistant director, and counselors. Many of the staff have college degrees or experience working with people with disabilities or are studying therapeutic recreation, education or a related field.

**Lunch:** Campers need to bring a sack lunch and drink to camp everyday. Lunches will not be refrigerated.

**Medication and Injury:** Campers who take medicine must bring a 32-day supply and specific instructions for administering it to the JBSRA office by May 26. Not all medications can be given out by JBSRA staff. Medication must be approved by the therapeutic recreation supervisor before it can be given to your child at camp. All medication must be in an original container. To avoid any confusion or lost medicine, and for safety, do not send medication to camp with your child. If your child is injured during camp hours, parents will be notified immediately. Staff members are provided with basic first aid training during orientation.

**Registration:** Registration will take place on Saturday, May 8 at the Annerino Community Center, 201 Recreation Drive in Bolingbrook. All registrations must be done in person. The registration deadline is Friday, May 28. If the maximum has been met, a wait list will be implemented based on order received. If you are unable to attend Saturday registration, registrations must be turned in at the JBSRA office, located at 230 E. Briarcliff Road, Bolingbrook, IL 60440, starting Monday, May 10.

In order for your registration to be processed, both the registration form and annual information form must be completed, along with 50% of the total camp fee. The balance is due June 18. No refunds will be given for missed days due to illness or vacation.

**Field Trips:** Several in-house field trips will be taken throughout the 8-week camp session. A camp schedule will be provided to campers in June. This includes swimming at the pool. On swim days, please pack a swimsuit, towel and sunscreen.
