Medical Aid Loan Closet

Disabilities that are temporary or transitional still present an immediate need for durable medical aids. To avoid purchasing these aids, residents may check them out for free, short-term use. The following items may be borrowed from the Closet: wheel chairs, walkers, transfer boards, toilet chairs, canes, crutches, and shower chairs.
